Competition Recap posts (medals and achievements)

Please include in your email:

- Skater's name
- Event name
- Result and/or medal or ribbon colour (gold, silver, bronze)
- A picture of your skater

We do try to track down results and photos through social media to include everyone, but it can be difficult to find clear photos for every skater. Family submissions are the most reliable way to ensure inclusion.

Photo submissions

Photos must be submitted by a parent or guardian.

Coaches are welcome to submit photos as well, but please don't rely on your coach. Coaches are often very busy during competitions and may be getting home late after the event. Submitting photos as a parent or guardian also ensures you have approved any image of your child that may be posted.

Behind-the-scenes photos (Facebook album)

After each event, we will also create a Facebook album with behind-the-scenes moments. If you have fun candid photos you'd like included, please send them to the same email address and clearly note which event they are from. These photos may also be used at the club banquet.
